Each family, or single person, that comes in and qualifies (based on gross income) may receive up to \$700 per year. We are so grateful for your donations to this program. Below is a story of one person who was blessed through the CAF.

I recently sat with someone who had spent their life in and out of prison, rehab, and homelessness. They came to Christ at a local church and were now trying to "figure out" why they were so broken. As I sat with them and talked about faith, sin, brokenness, and the gospel in action they looked up with tears and said,

"I can't understand why someone else would pay for me to come get help."

This person was only able to come into our office because of generous donors who have given faithfully to the Client Assistance Fund (CAF). Our CAF allows clients, who don't have the resources to receive help, get the help they need regardless of their ability to pay. At the end of our sessions, this client looked at me and said,

"As soon as I get on my feet, I am giving to the CAF so others can get the help they need."

This person is currently working a full-time job (for the first time in a decade!), a faithful member of a church, and in the process of securing a long-term home. God is so good!
