We are amazed and humbled by the growth God has given this organization over the last 30+ years. In the 1990s, NCCC began with 1 clinician working 1 day per week; We have now grown to 11 clinicians working various hours Monday through Friday. In 2023 we also added an addiction program overseen by Tom Solem. NCCC currently operates out of two locations, one in Faith Evangelical Free Church and one in the Grand Cities Mall. We began a building fundraiser to raise \$750,000 and started remodeling a space at 1615 17th Ave S; Grand Forks, ND 58201 with the property to be leased from Hope Church. Plans include consolidating both offices and moving into the new location in March of 2024.
